Introduksjon

Det systematiske søket om integrering av innvandrere i Norden ble gjort av Andreas Anker, Elin Hammer Tveito og Mathias Sunde Valseth. Alle sammen er bachelorstudenter på bibliotek- og informasjonsvitenskap ved Oslomet.

Oppdraget fra NordForsk var blant annet å foreta et søk etter forskning som omhandlet integrering av flyktninger i Norden i perioden 2000 til 2022. Søkene ble gjort på engelsk og skandinaviske språk i syv forskjellige databaser. Det resulterte i 3719 referanser som etter screening var redusert til 630 inkluderte referanser og 3089 ekskluderte referanser. Dette gir en inklusjonsprosent på 16.9 prosent.

Totalt resulterte søket i 15 danske artikler, 515 engelske artikler, 19 norske artikler, 13 svenske artikler og 68 norske rapporter. Vi har tilstrebet å gjøre søkene så systematiske og transparente som det lar seg gjøre med tanke på etterrettelighet og etterprøvbarehet.

For dette søket begynte vi først med å identifisere potensielle databaser. Vi ble anbefalt ASSIA, ASU, SCOPUS og SOCINDEX av flere bibliotekarer i tillegg til ORIA for søk etter norske artikler og grålitteratur i form av rapporter. ASU og SOCINDEX ble benyttet med Ebscohost som grensesnitt. Vi valgte Swepub og Det kgl. Bibliotek for søket etter svenske og danske artikler da de lot oss søke i og begrense treffene etter artikler fra fagfelleverderte tidsskrifter. Vi ble også anbefalt å søke i bibliotek.dk av Det kgl. Bibliotek, men valgte å ikke bruke denne da man ikke kunne begrense etter fagfellevurdering.

Vi brukte en form for PICO skjema for å gruppere søketermer sammen. Vi brukte Google Translate, diverse interne tesauruser, humord, svenske og danske ressurspersoner i NordForsk, og relevante artikler for å finne potensielle søketermer vi kunne ta i bruk i søkene våre. Vi fagfelleverderte hverandres søkestrenger før søkene ble gjennomført. Når søkene var gjennomført lastet vi ned referansene til Endnote og gjennomførte duplikatkontroll.

Søk i ORIA etter norske artikler ble gjennomført 15.04.2022 og ga følgende resultater:

N=1307. Grunnet knapphet på tid ble treffene sortert etter relevans og kun de 400 første ble lastet ned til Endnote og screenet.
Etter screening n=19.

ORIA (Rapporter)

Søk i ORIA etter norske rapporter ble gjennomført både 15.04.2022 og 18.04 da vi så muligheten for å få med flere relevante treff ved å utvide søket.

Totalt nedlastede referanser n=185.
Etter screening n=68.

Det Kgl. Bibliotek

Søk i Det Kgl. Bibliotek etter danske artikler ble gjort 18.04 og resulterte i n=222 artikler.
Etter screening n=15.

Swepub

Søk i Swepub etter svenske artikler ble gjort 18.04 og resulterte i n=37.
Etter screening n=13.

Totalt

Videre søk

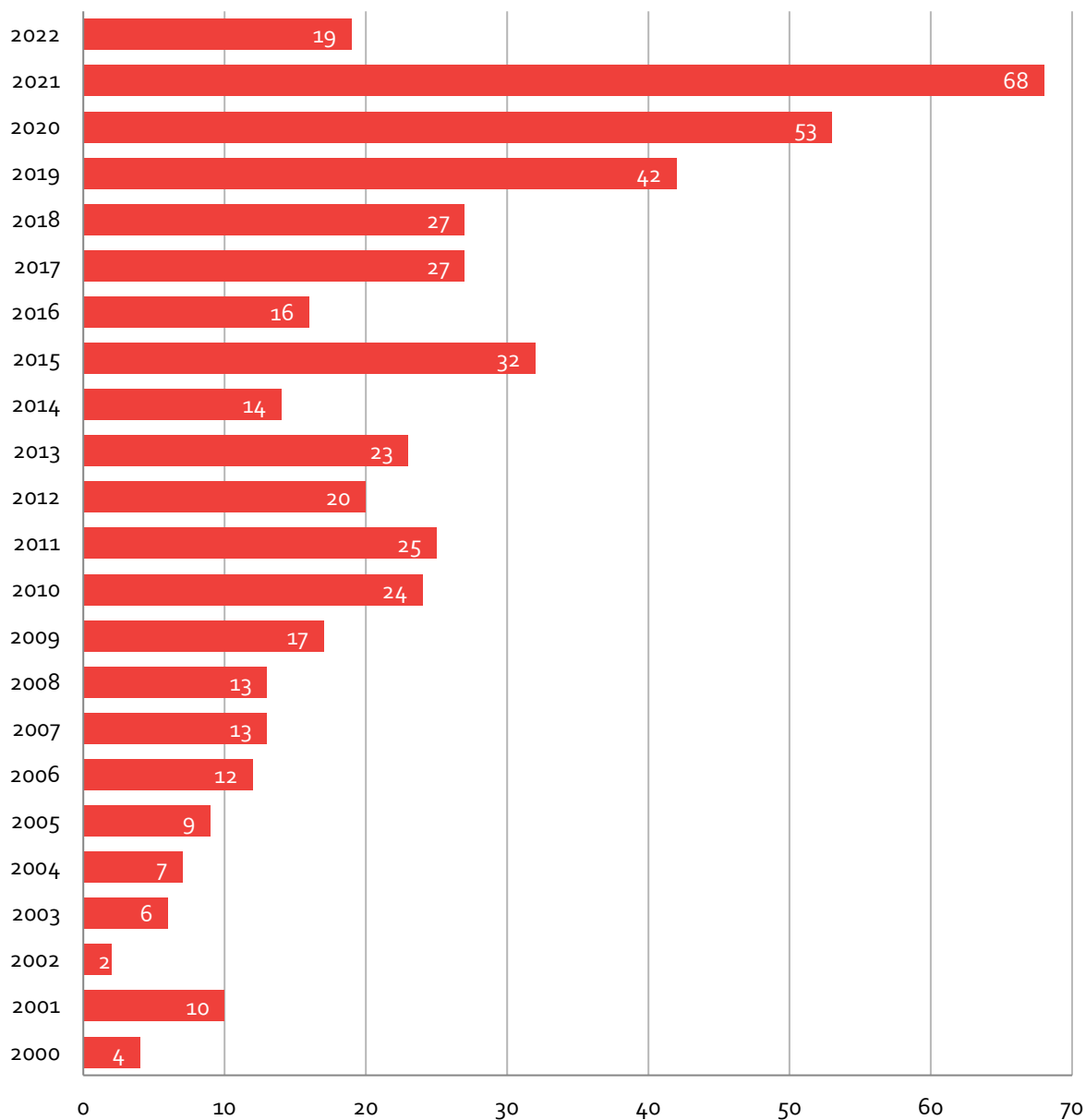
